SNPJ Sanctioned Scramble Golf Rules

as approved at the National Athletic Board Meeting on April 28, 2006

1. The SNPJ Sanctioned Scramble Golf Tournament shall be four person teams, of which all players tee off, and the group hits their second, third, fourth, etc. shots from where the best ball lays until the ball is sank into the hole.
2. All men must tee off from the white tees and the women tee off from the tees just ahead. In no way shall any player use the gold senior tees.
3. Players must drop their ball within one club length from where the best shot landed except on the greens. The player can not improve his/her lie and can not place his/her ball from the rough to the fairway or from the sandtrap to the fairway. On the greens, ball must be placed within 2 inches of the mark but no closer to the hole.
4. Each team must use at least two drives from each golfer on each nine holes.
5. Your team must hole out on every green. There are NO GIMMEES.
6. The team is responsible for totaling up the actual score per hole, showing their total for the first nine, the second nine, and their combined score for all 18 holes. Score cards must be attested.
7. Non-Member (Social) Guests are allowed to play but, in addition to the regular entry fee, they must also pay any additional monies that the Society contributes to the prize fund for member golfers. Only 1 non-member (Social) golfer per foursome is allowed.
8. Three-man teams are allowed only one stroke per golfer per shot on each hole.
9. Circle all birdie or better holes.

OPTIONAL RULES

1. **SKINS:** Each foursome can enter the skins competition for a fee as to be determined by the tournament committee prior to the first tee off. You must enter the skins competition before your first tee off. No skins will be accepted after your team starts play.

You must get a birdie or better on the hole to qualify for a skin. If there are more than one low score on a hole, that hole is disqualified as a skin hole. All birdies and eagles count for one skin only. The entire amount of the skins fee collected will be divided among all qualified skin holes.
2. **INDIVIDUAL CONTESTS:** On the noted holes for the following contests you **MUST PLAY** your own drive to compete in the contest. You must also abide by the scramble rules to complete the scramble hole.
 - A. **CLOSEST TO THE PIN** and **CLOSEST TO THE PIN IN TWO:** The ball must clearly be on the green to qualify.
 - B. **LONGEST DRIVE:** The ball must be clearly in the fairway to count.
